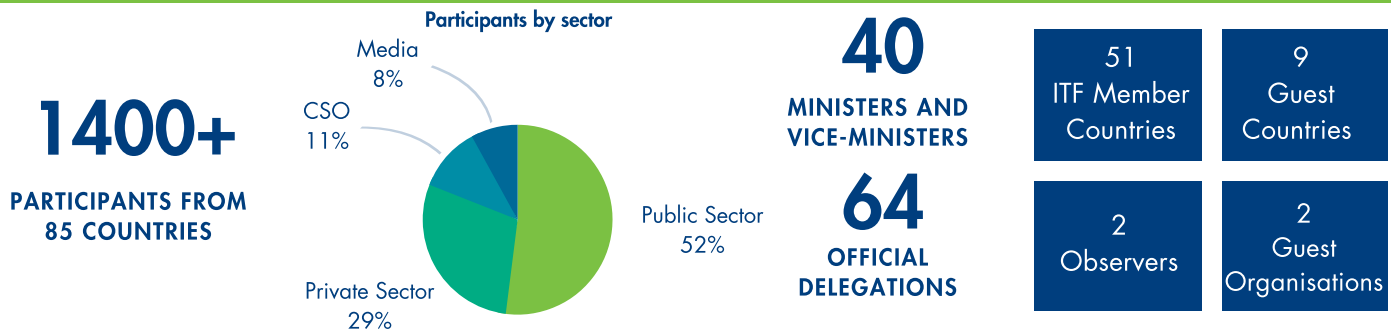


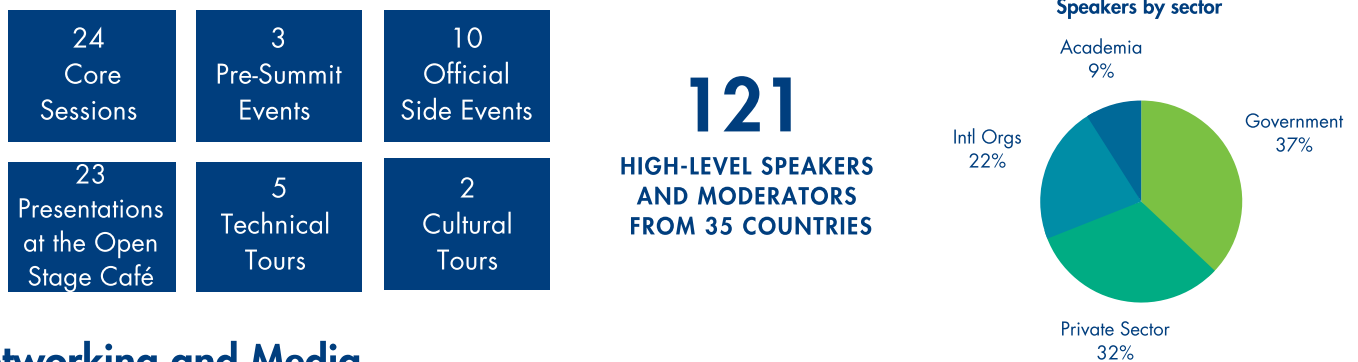
The ITF Annual Summit at a glance
